Brush up: Swiss Domestic and International Taxation

Taxation has become a crucial area for law practitioners around the world. In this context, the Brush Up Course offers a general overview of the Swiss domestic and international tax principles by using practical case studies, which allow the participants to understand the Swiss tax system from a practical perspective.

Course content

The Brush Up Course guides the participants through the principles of the Swiss domestic and international tax system, helping them understand and apply these concepts and determine the tax obligations for individuals and corporate entities. In general terms, the Course will cover the following topics:

- Individual taxation
- Corporate taxation with a particular emphasis on the amendments implemented by the Corporate Tax Reform
- Particularities on certain federal and cantonal taxes
- International taxation, focusing on the application of the Swiss tax treaty network

Value of the course

Understanding tax law has become a crucial element in any business. This course is geared towards attendees who are not familiar with the Swiss tax system. After completing the Brush Up Course participants will have a solid knowledge on the most relevant Swiss domestic and international tax issues. As way of example, at the end of the program, attendees will understand and be able to apply the Swiss domestic tax principles

to corporate and wealth management structures. Further, by working with case studies, attendees will be able to apply tax concepts from a practical perspective.
